# FEMA's Local Mitigation Planning Handbook



FEMA released updated <u>state</u> and <u>local</u> policies for hazard mitigation planning in April 2022. These are now in effect for plan approvals as of April 19, 2023. To facilitate successful plan development or updates, FEMA is beginning to update handbooks that accompany the policy guides, including the <u>Local</u> <u>Mitigation Planning Handbook</u>.

- What should you know: The Handbook organizes the process for completing or updating a Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) around four steps and nine recommended tasks. It accounts for <u>policy changes or</u> <u>updates</u> that include integrating the effects of future conditions in risk assessments, defining who is required to be involved in the local planning process, and aligning with mitigation programs like the <u>National Flood Insurance Program</u> and the <u>Community Rating System</u>.
- Why this matters: The HMP process can be long and labor intensive, but it is an important investment in the future of your community. Also having an approved mitigation plan is a <u>pre-requisite</u> for some nonemergency disaster assistance like the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) and Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) planning and project grants. To maximize the impact of the HMP and to ensure a seamless approval by both your state and FEMA, using available resources to guide planning is essential.
- Resources you should know about: In addition to FEMA's handbooks and policy guides, you can also sign up to receive mitigation planning updates and notifications regarding policy updates. FEMA regularly conducts webinars on aspects of the HMP process. Your state is also a primary resource to guide the HMP process the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), for example, provides information on HMP regulations and guidance, training resources, email updates, and contact information for Cal OES representatives within the Hazard Mitigation Planning Division.
